
Anamnesis: Lord, By Your Cross

In the Spring of 1969 I wrote several settings of the so-called *Anamnesis*, now called the *Memorial Acclamation*. We used this particular setting at St. Lucy's Church in Campbell, CA for over 30 years. As happenstance would have it, yesterday I found a dittograph (look it up if you don't know) of this acclamation with an obligato written for choir/men's voices buried in the pages of a long-forgotten book of organ music that I used to play on occasion. I have always liked this setting and used it with great success for many many years. So I thought I would post it to my website where, perhaps, someone will find it one day and maybe even use it once again. It is not part of any particular Mass setting and was used independently. Today's custom is to write such acclamations within the musical context of an entire Ordinary.
